It was decided that we would meet once a month, on the first Wednesday at 2:00 pm. That would make the next meeting to be **Wednesday, 3 May** at the vineyard.

We were a little down on numbers this month through various lurgies, family visits and general 'stuff'; nevertheless huge fun was had by all.

It was lovely that some folk brought their own material and were itching to get started to style it into a bonsai. Interesting mixture from privet to oak!



As a starter to the proceedings and a link to the last session whereby the group decided the styling of a rather scruffy Blackthorn, this was shown just four weeks later coming into leaf.



The main session was divided into two sections; a little theory covering some of the twelve main bonsai styles, formal upright, informal upright, cascade and a rare style called Tanuki. Examples of each were shown and discussed.





Also in the 'theory part' some of the important bonsai terms and expressions were explained; a 'jin', a 'shari' and the 'nebari.







The second part of the afternoon was a demonstration of how to pot a tree from a plastic pot in which it had be trained, into a proper bonsai pot. In this case it was an Alder that had almost come into leaf so may be deemed a little late in the season, yet hopefully would survive nicely nonetheless.
